Eligibility:

Open to a **nationally** affiliated FCCLA member who:

- is currently a senior (grade 12) in high school
- affiliated with national FCCLA by March 1, 2010
- has taken the SAT or ACT exam
- applied to a degree-granting institution leading to an associate's or bachelor's degree in any field of study
- has outstanding leadership qualities gained through FCCLA membership and other experiences in their family, school, and community.

Applicants with a strong academic background are preferred.

Instructions:

1. Type all information using 10pt. Times New Roman font.
2. Do not alter this form in any way or use abbreviations.
3. Complete all sections of the application.
4. List information chronologically beginning with the earliest date first.
5. Use only the space provided. Do not send additional pages. Applicants will be judged solely on information contained in this form and your recommendations. Applications cannot be returned to applicant.
6. Attach your most recent official high school transcript including the first semester grades of your senior year. Your official high school transcript must also include standardized college entrance exam scores (ACT and/or SAT).
7. Include a copy of your chapter affiliation verifying national dues paid by March 1, 2010.
8. Applicants must include two (2) recommendations: One from their local adviser and one from an individual knowledgeable of student's non-FCCLA activities. (*Recommendations must be signed and no more than 100 words*).
9. All signatures must be included in this application.
10. Application deadline: Must be postmarked by April 1, 2010.

Applications will be evaluated for style and expression as well as content. Conciseness of written remarks is recommended. This scholarship is a one-time cash award payable directly to the recipient's college or university in the fall of their first year. Funds must be applied toward tuition, room, and/or board. If the recipient withdraws from college, unused funds must be returned to FCCLA. The winner will be notified by **May 2010**. Scholarship winners are invited to attend the 2010 FCCLA National Leadership Conference, in Chicago, Illinois, to receive recognition for their award.
