2010 National Award Guidelines

Family, Career and Community Leaders of America recognizes an individual who exemplifies professional management of the state association, dedication to FCCLA, and strong support of the national organization and its programs.

The mission of Family, Career and Community Leaders of America (FCCLA) is to promote personal growth and leadership development through family and consumer sciences education. Focusing on the multiple roles of family member, wage earner, and community leader, members develop skills for life through: character development, creative and critical thinking, interpersonal communication, practical knowledge, and vocational preparation.

The purpose of FCCLA is

- To provide opportunities for personal development and preparation for adult life.
- To strengthen the function of the family as the basic unit of society.
- To encourage democracy through cooperative action in the home and community.
- To encourage individual and group involvement in helping achieve global cooperation and harmony.
- To promote greater understanding between youth and adults.
- To provide opportunities for making decisions and for assuming responsibilities.
- To prepare for the multiple roles of men and women in today's society.
- To promote family and consumer sciences, careers and related occupations.

DEADLINE:

All nominations are due to FCCLA NATIONAL HEADQUARTERS postmarked by April 1, 2010. Nominations sent after the April 1, 2010 postmark deadline will not be considered.

Criteria:

The award will be presented to the individual who exemplifies professional management of the state association, dedication to FCCLA, and strong support of the national organization and its programs. An evaluation committee will be comprised of a chapter adviser, FCCLA member, and a representative from business and industry will evaluate nomination. A committee will select the recipient, and the award will be presented at the National Leadership Meeting.

- All activities reported must have occurred between April 1 and March 31.
- Please provide three letters of support, one from a state officer, one from a chapter adviser, and one from an individual of the nominator's choice.

Official Rules:

- Nominations may be submitted by the nominee, a chapter adviser, a state officer, a school administrator, teacher educator, a national officer, state board of directors, or state education administrator/supervisor.
- Nominees must be currently responsible for day-to-day management of the state FCCLA Association, regardless of title.
- All nominees must be current members of FCCLA National Alumni & Associates.
- Nominations must be typed.
- Winners will be selected based on the judge's evaluation of the given criteria. Judge's decisions are final.
- One winner will be selected from eligible nominations.
- For award consideration, nominations must be postmarked by April 1, 2010, and sent to FCCLA National Headquarters.
- Winner will be recognized at the 2009 National Leadership Conference in Chicago, Illinois and are asked to submit a photo for use in the printed program.
