Lesson Plan Goals & Objectives (Specify skills/information that will be learned.)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • To understand the causes and effects of hunger and nutrition in areas around the world. • How children and families are affected. • What resources are available and how we can help.

Introduction of Subject (Give and/or demonstrate necessary information)	Watch Feed the Children video on the Smart board. Discuss some causes and ideas on how we can help.

Activity 1 (Describe the independent activity to reinforce this lesson)	Discuss causes and effects of hunger around the world, the U.S., state, and our own city or county. Choose a specific country or state affected by hunger. Students will research statistics on causes, related diseases from malnutrition, how it affects families, if there are resources available to help.
Activity 2 (Describe the independent activity to reinforce this lesson)	Students prepare a paper using the information researched. The paper will include a cover page and a works cited page.
Activity 3 (Describe the independent activity to reinforce this lesson)	Students create a Power Point presentation for the class, and present.
Summary/Evaluation (Assign Homework, or Reflect on the Outcomes)	Create and facilitate an FCCLA project for Feed the Children national project, and report the project to state and national FCCLA.
