



Starting Zinnia Zahara Coral Rose Seeds Indoors

Plant 2 seeds in each pot $\frac{1}{4}$ inch deep in potting soil that has good drainage. Place the pot in bright filtered light but not in direct sun. Keep the soil moist but not wet. The seeds should sprout in approximately 7 days. Once the seedlings have emerged and developed their second set of leaves, thin to 1 plant per pot. The Zinnia's can stay in these pots or can be transplanted outside to be enjoyed in the garden.

Starting Zinnia Zahara Coral Rose Seeds Outdoors

The seeds should be planted in the spring after all danger of frost has past. Choose a place in a sunny location. Zinnia's aren't picky about their soil, but well drained soil would be the best. Loosen the top 1" of the soil. Spread the seeds across the top of the prepared area and cover with a thin layer of soil. Keep the soil moist but not wet. The seeds should sprout in approximately 7 days. Once the seedlings have emerged and developed their second set of leaves, thin them out so that each seedling is about 6-8" apart.
