FCCLA Leaders to Watch is a contest for FCCLA student members and advisers.

Rules

- This is an individual contest for FCCLA student members and advisers.
- Chapters may submit up to three student members and one adviser.
- Contest entries must include an FCCLA Leaders to Watch Contest Form and a photograph of the student/adviser which reflects the professional image of FCCLA.
- Contest entries should use the appropriate contest form (student or adviser) and may not exceed one page. Contest forms can be found on the Contest page of the FCCLA national website.
- Photographs must be of 300 pixels/inch resolution (2MPs or above) for a 2" x 4" image size. If photographs are taken by a professional photographer a Professional Photographer Release should be sent with the Consent & Release Agreement.
- Contest entries must be submitted using the below method or will be disqualified prior to voting.

Submission Method

- All contest entries should be submitted via email to competitiveevents@fclclainc.org.
- The email body should include the following information:
 - Chapter Name
 - School
 - School Phone
 - State
 - Adviser
 - Adviser's Email
 - Signed Consent & Release Agreement and Professional Photographer Release, if applicable. (indicate whether it is attached, faxed, or mailed)
- The contest form and photograph should be attached to the email.
- A signed copy of the Consent and Release Agreement must be submitted with each entry. This may be attached to the email, faxed to (703) 860-2713, or mailed to the following address:

Contest Voting

- A national committee will narrow entries down to one student and one adviser per state.
- These advancing entries will be displayed at the 2010 National Leadership Conference in Chicago, Illinois.
- Meeting attendees will cast their vote for the top FCCLA Leaders to Watch on site with ballots received at registration.

Recognition

- The top 10 students and top 10 advisers will be announced at the Closing General Session of the 2010 FCCLA National Leadership Conference.
- The top 10 students and top 10 advisers will be featured in the 2010 November/December issue of *Teen Times*.
- The top 10 students and top 10 advisers will be recognized on the FCCLA national website.
